

KNOW...

- All scorpion species have venom, but not all are dangerous to humans.
- There are at least 16 different species in Yelapa, each one with different grades of toxicity.
- 9 of those are specifically of the **Centruroides** genus (bark scorpions, also known as "blond" scorpions), which are usually dangerous to humans.
- It's very hard to tell the species apart, so the only way to know if you need the serum is to pay attention to the symptoms.
- Scorpion venom has neurotoxins, cardiovascular toxins, and toxins that induce necrotic inflammation.
- The only thing that can effectively neutralize it is the anti-venom serum. Nothing else will work.
- If you took a remedy and don't get a reaction, it does not mean that your remedy is "working". It only means that
 you were stung by a non-dangerous species and/or an individual with a depleted venom sac, for example, after
 hunting.

IF STUNG...

- Stay CALM, focus on breathing slowly and relaxing your muscles. You will have plenty of time to act if needed.
- Let people around you know that you were stung.
- Do not take or apply anything at all Particularly antihistamines like Benadryl or home remedies, as they
 will only mask the symptoms, which could be very dangerous.
- Do not use venom "extractors" or make cuts on the area They won't work at all and could make things
 worse by spreading the toxins.
- Pay calm attention to the signs and symptoms:

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS

- 1. You WILL feel a sharp pain where it stung ALWAYS
- 2. The area MIGHT get red, numb, and/or swollen NOT ALWAYS
- 3. You MIGHT feel the venom "moving": a warm local sensation and/or light numbness starting at the stung area and spreading slowly up or down your extremity or body NOT ALWAYS
- 4. You MIGHT feel numbness on your lips and/or mouth, and/or tickles in your throat, "like hairs" NOT ALWAYS

If you have ONLY the first 3- There is no immediate need to do anything.

If the symptoms get to 4 you should get the serum.

DO NOT PANIC. You still have plenty of time!
